Bulk Variance

Representatives: John DeSimone-Esq, Roger Dewalt-owner, Glenn McAllister-PLS, Joseph Arsenault-Environmental Consultant were sworn in.

The applicant proposes to install an additional 50' x 99' (4950 SF) pole barn on his premises for storage of machine shop materials only; no manufacturing or chemical storage. The pole barn would be located behind and adjacent to a similarly size metal accessory building. The site also contains nearby metal garage and pool house. The variance request is for the number of accessory buildings.
